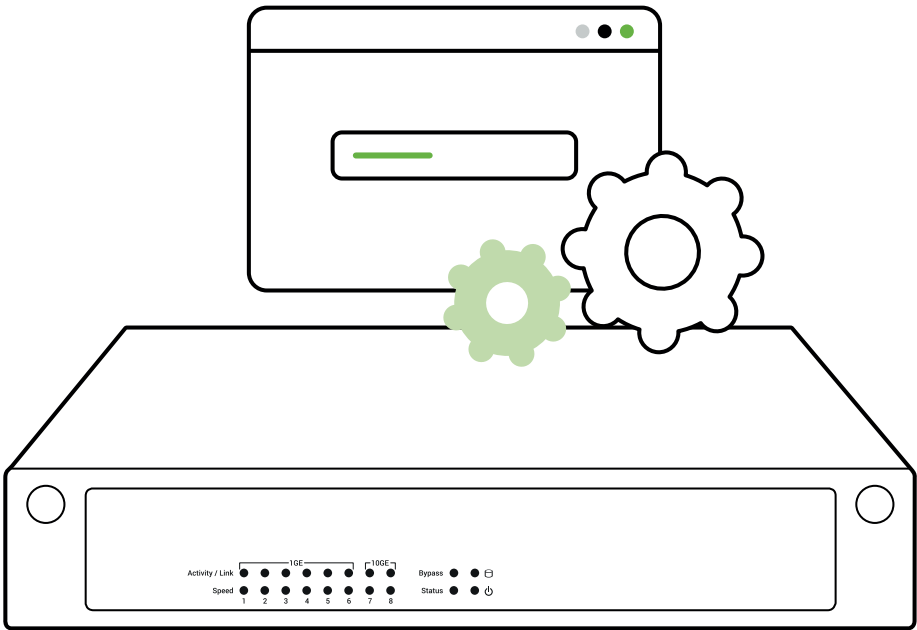

Endian UTM Software



endian

What you have and what you need

You have:

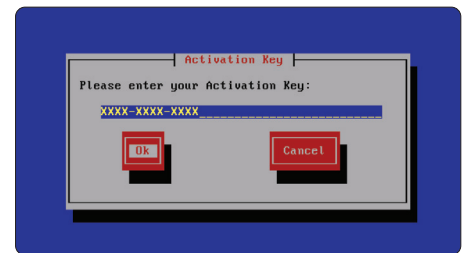
- ✓ A download link (valid for two weeks) for the ISO image
- ✓ An activation code

To install Endian UTM Software Appliance and protect your network you need the following:

- ✓ A computer with at least 1 Ethernet port, a free USB Port, an x86_64 compatible CPU with at least 1GHz, 2GB of RAM and a hard disk drive of at least 8 GB
- ✓ A working Internet connection
- ✓ A empty USB Flash Drive

Endian UTM Software Appliance Installation Procedure

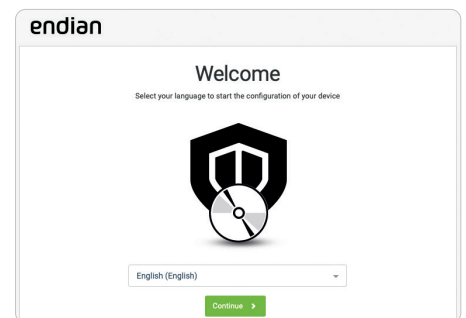
1. Downloaded Endian UTM Software ISO image
2. Create bootable USB flash drives from ISO Image
3. Boot the computer from the USB Drive
4. On the first screen press “Enter” to start the installation
5. Choose your language
6. Press “Enter” again
7. Insert the Activation Key
8. If your computer has 2 hard disk drives of the same dimension, you can enable RAID 1 mirroring
9. If your computer has a serial port, you can activate the serial console
10. At the end of the installation you must configure the internal IP address of your Endian UTM Software Appliance. This address will then be used to administer the machine.
11. Your Endian UTM Software Appliance is now installed.



Web Interface

Open your Internet browser (e.g. Mozilla Firefox) and go to the IP address that you configured in step 9 of the installation procedure

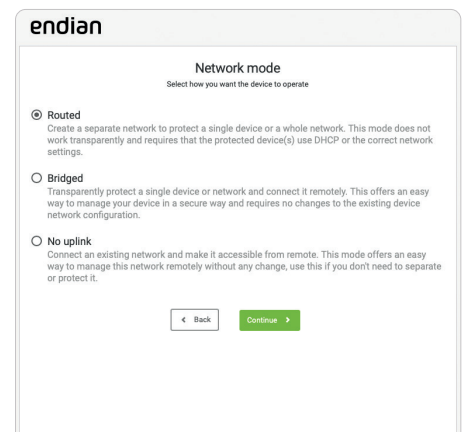
- ✓ The system will redirect you to <https://<IP address>:10443/> and ask you for your preferred language and to accept the license agreement.
- ✓ The system will now ask you to choose the Configuration Mode. If using appliance as standalone device choose “Setup Assistant” in order to complete device setup.



Choose Your Internet Connection Mode

Now it is time to configure your Internet connection:

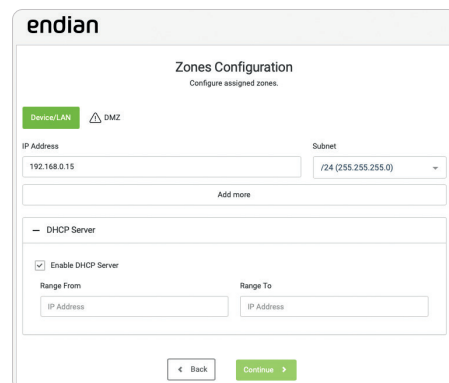
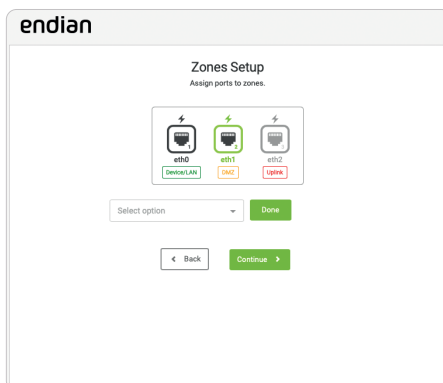
1. Choose your network mode
 - **Routed:** if you want to use the appliance as router in your network
 - **Bridged:** if you want your appliance to act transparently without having to change the existing network infrastructure
 - **No uplink:** if the appliance should not act as a router but require clients to address it directly
2. When choosing routed mode, the uplink type must be specified:
 - Ethernet Static
 - Ethernet DHCP
 - Broadband (PPPoE)



Network settings

Now it is time to configure your Internet connection:

- Every network area is color-coded:
 - Device/LAN:** This is the safe network where your trusted computers are.
 - Uplink (WAN):** Usually this is the interface connected to the internet.
 - WIFI (Hotspot):** It is suggested to place the computers that use wireless connections in this area. This kind of network is usually not as safe as a wired one.
 - DMZ:** Network for servers connected to the Internet (DMZ). It is meant for the server machines that have to provide services on RED. This way, even if the security of one of these servers has been compromised, the GREEN area will remain safe.
- Choose your configuration and assign network interfaces to every zone (select one or more network interfaces for each zone) you want to use. Follow all the wizard steps to configure your Endian appliance and protect your network.



Endian Network Account

To activate your Endian Network subscription and keep your appliance always up-to-date with the latest features and security updates follow these steps:

A. You already have an Endian Network account

- When the system asks you if you have an Endian Network account choose “yes” and go to the next step.
- Now fill in the form using your data and the Activation Key.

B. You do not have an Endian Network account

- When the system asks you if you have an Endian Network account choose “no” and go to the next step.
- Click on the “Endian Network account” link and insert the Activation Key.
- Fill in the registration form and create your account.
- Close the registration window and go to the next step.
- Now fill in the form using your data
